



BIBLE SEEDS OF PROSPERITY

- 2 CORINTHIANS 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.
- GALATIANS 3:14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
- GALATIANS 3:16 Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ.
- HEBREWS 10:1 For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image....
- GALATIANS 2:6 But from those who seemed to be something--whatever they were, it makes no difference to me; God shows personal favouritism to no man....
- ACTS 10:34 Then Peter opened his mouth and said: "In truth, I perceive that God shows no partiality.
- ROMANS 2:11 For there is no partiality with God.
- GENESIS 1:28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."
- GENESIS 9:1 So God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them: "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth.



- GENESIS 9:7 And as for you, be fruitful and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the earth and multiply in it."
- GENESIS 12:2 I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great, and you shall be a blessing.
- GENESIS 13:2 Abram was very rich in livestock, in silver, and in gold.
- GENESIS 24:1 Now Abraham was old, well-advanced in age; and the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things.
- GENESIS 24:35 "The Lord has blessed my master greatly, and he has become great; and He has given him flocks and herds, silver and gold, male and female servants, and camels and donkeys.
- GENESIS 26:12 Then Isaac sowed in that land, and reaped in the same year a hundredfold, and the Lord blessed him.
- GENESIS 26:13 The man began to prosper, and continued prospering until he became very prosperous;
- GENESIS 26:14 for he had possessions of flocks and possessions of herds and a great number of servants. So the Philistines envied him.
- GENESIS 30:43 Thus the man became exceedingly prosperous, and had large flocks, female and male servants, and camels and donkeys.
- GENESIS 39:2 The Lord was with Joseph, and he was a successful man, and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.
- GENESIS 39:3 And his master saw that the Lord was with him and that the Lord made all he did to prosper in his hand.
- GENESIS 39:5 So it was, from the time that he had made him overseer of his house and all that he had, that the Lord blessed the Egyptians house for Joseph's sake; and the blessing of the Lord was on all that he had in the house and in the field.



- GENESIS 39:23 The keeper of the prison did not look into anything that was under Joseph's hand, because the Lord was with him; and whatever he did, the Lord made it prosper.
- EXODUS 19:5 'Now, therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine.
- LEVITICUS 25:21 'Then I will command My blessing on you in the sixth year, and it will bring forth produce enough for three years.
- LEVITICUS 25:23 'The land shall not be sold permanently, for the land is Mine; for you are strangers and sojourners with Me.
- LEVITICUS 26:9 For I will look on you favourably and make you fruitful, multiply you and confirm My covenant with you.
- DEUTERONOMY 2:7 "For the Lord your God has blessed you in all the work of your hand. He knows your trudging through this great wilderness. These forty years the Lord your God has been with you; you have lacked nothing."
- DEUTERONOMY 7:13 "And He will love you and bless you and multiply you; He will also bless the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your land, your grain and your new wine and your oil, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flock, in the land of which He swore to your fathers to give you.
- DEUTERONOMY 8:9 "a land in which you will eat bread without scarcity, in which you will lack nothing; a land whose stones are iron and out of whose hills you can dig copper.
- DEUTERONOMY 8:10 "When you have eaten and are full, then you shall bless the Lord your God for the good land which He has given you.
- DEUTERONOMY 8:13 "and when your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold are multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied;



- DEUTERONOMY 8:18 "And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you the power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.
- DEUTERONOMY 15:4 "except when there may be no poor among you; for the Lord will greatly bless you in the land which the Lord your God is giving you to possess as an inheritance--
- DEUTERONOMY 15:6 "For the Lord your God will bless you just as He promised you; you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow; you shall reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over you.
- DEUTERONOMY 15:10 "You shall surely give to him, and your heart should not be grieved when you give to him, because for this thing the Lord your God will bless you in all your works and in all to which you put your hand.
- DEUTERONOMY 16:15 "Seven days you shall keep a sacred feast to the Lord your God in the place which the Lord chooses because the Lord your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands so that you surely rejoice.
- DEUTERONOMY 28:2 "And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you because you obey the voice of the Lord your God:
- DEUTERONOMY 28:3 "Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country.
- DEUTERONOMY 28:4 "Blessed shall be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground and the increase of your herds, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks.
- DEUTERONOMY 28:5 "Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl.
- DEUTERONOMY 28:6 "Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out.



- DEUTERONOMY 28:8 "The Lord will command the blessing on you in your storehouses and in all to which you set your hand, and He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God is giving you.
- DEUTERONOMY 28:11 "And the Lord will grant you plenty of goods, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your ground, in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you.
- DEUTERONOMY 28:12 "The Lord will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.
- DEUTERONOMY 28:13 "And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you today, and are careful to observe them.
- DEUTERONOMY 29:9 "Therefore keep the words of this covenant, and do them, that you may prosper in all that you do.
- DEUTERONOMY 30:5 "Then the Lord your God will bring you to the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it. He will prosper you and multiply you more than your fathers.
- DEUTERONOMY 30:9 "The Lord your God will make you abound in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your land for good. For the Lord will again rejoice over you for good as He rejoiced over your fathers,
- DEUTERONOMY 30:19 "I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live;
- JOSHUA 1:7 "Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant



commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.

- JOSHUA 1:8 "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.
- JUDGES 18:10 "When you go, you will come to a secure people and large land. For God has given it into your hands, a place where there is no lack of anything that is on the earth."
- RUTH 2:1 And Naomi had a kinsman of her husband's, a man of great wealth, of the family of Elimelech; his name was Boaz.
- 2 SAMUEL 6:11 The ark of the Lord remained in the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite three months. And the Lord blessed Obed-Edom and all his household.
- 2 SAMUEL 6:12 And it was told King David, saying, "The Lord has blessed the house of Obed-Edom and all that belongs to him, because of the ark of God." So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed-Edom to the City of David with gladness.
- 1 KINGS 2:3 "And keep the charge of the Lord your God: to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, His commandments, His judgments, and His testimonies, as it is written in the Law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do and wherever you turn;
- 1 KINGS 3:11 Then God said to him: "Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice,
- 1 KINGS 3:13 "And I have also given you what you have not asked: both riches and honour so that there shall not be anyone like you among the kings all your days.



- 1 KINGS 10:7 "However I did not believe the words until I came and saw it with my own eyes, and indeed the half was not told me. Your wisdom and prosperity exceed the fame of which I heard.
- 1 KINGS 10:23 So King Solomon surpassed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom.
- 1 KINGS 10:27 The king made silver as common in Jerusalem as stones, and he made cedars as abundant as the sycamores which are in the lowland.
- 2 KINGS 18:7 The Lord was with him; he prospered wherever he went. And he rebelled against the king of Assyria and did not serve him.
- 1 CHRONICLES 4:10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, "Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!" So God granted him what he requested.
- 1 CHRONICLES 22:5 Now David said, "Solomon my son is young and inexperienced, and the house that is to be built for the Lord must be exceedingly magnificent, famous and glorious throughout all countries. I will now make preparation for it." So David made abundant preparations before his death.
- 1 CHRONICLES 22:14 "Indeed I have taken much trouble to prepare for the house of the Lord one hundred thousand talents of gold and one million talents of silver, and bronze and iron beyond measure, for it is so abundant. I have prepared timber and stone also, and you may add to them.
- 1 CHRONICLES 22:16 "Of gold and silver and bronze and iron there is no limit. Arise and begin working, and the Lord be with you."
- 1 CHRONICLES 29:2 "Now for the house of my God I have prepared with all my might: gold for things to be made of gold, silver for things of silver, bronze for things of bronze, iron for things of iron, wood for things of wood, onyx stones, stones to be set, glistening stones of various colours, all kinds of precious stones, and marble slabs in abundance.



- 1 CHRONICLES 29:11 Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all.
- 1 CHRONICLES 29:12 Both riches and honour come from You, and You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand, it is to make great and to give strength to all.
- 1 CHRONICLES 29:16 "O Lord our God, all this abundance that we have prepared to build You a house for Your holy name is from Your hand and is all Your own.
- 1 CHRONICLES 29:21 And they made sacrifices to the Lord and offered burnt offerings to the Lord on the next day: a thousand bulls, a thousand rams, a thousand lambs, with their drink offerings, and sacrifices in abundance for all Israel.
- 1 CHRONICLES 29:23 Then Solomon sat on the throne of the Lord as king instead of David his father and prospered, and all Israel obeyed him.
- 1 CHRONICLES 29:28 So he died in a good old age, full of days and riches and honour; and Solomon his son reigned in his place.
- 2 CHRONICLES 1:11 And God said to Solomon: "Because this was in your heart, and you have not asked riches or wealth or honour or the life of your enemies, nor have you asked long life--but have asked wisdom and knowledge for yourself, that you may judge My people over whom I have made you king--
- 2 CHRONICLES 1:12 "wisdom and knowledge are granted to you; and I will give you riches and wealth and honour, such as none of the kings have had who have been before you, nor shall any after you have the like."
- 2 CHRONICLES 1:15 Also the king made silver and gold as common in Jerusalem as stones, and he made cedars as abundant as the sycamores which are in the lowland.



- 2 CHRONICLES 4:18 And Solomon had all these articles made in such great abundance that the weight of the bronze was not determined.
- 2 CHRONICLES 9:20 All King Solomon's drinking vessels were of gold, and all the vessels of the House of the Forest of Lebanon were of pure gold. Not one was of silver, for this was accounted as nothing in the days of Solomon.
- 2 CHRONICLES 9:22 So King Solomon surpassed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom.
- 2 CHRONICLES 9:27 The king made silver as common in Jerusalem as stones, and he made cedar trees as abundant as the sycamores which are in the lowland.
- 2 CHRONICLES 14:7 Therefore he said to Judah, "Let us build these cities and make walls around them, and towers, gates, and bars, while the land is yet before us, because we have sought the Lord our God; we have sought Him, and He has given us rest on every side." So they built and prospered.
- 2 CHRONICLES 17:5 Therefore the Lord established the kingdom in his hand, and all Judah gave presents to Jehoshaphat, and he had riches and honour in abundance.
- 2 CHRONICLES 18:1 Jehoshaphat had riches and honour in abundance; and by marriage, allied himself with Ahab.
- 2 CHRONICLES 20:20 And they rose early in the morning and went out into the Wilderness of Tekoa; and as they went out, Jehoshaphat stood and said, "Hear me, O Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem: Believe in the Lord your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper."
- 2 CHRONICLES 20:25 When Jehoshaphat and his people came to take away their spoil, they found among them an abundance of valuables on the dead bodies, and precious jewellery, which they stripped off for themselves, more than they could carry away; and they were three days gathering the spoil because there was so much.



- 2 CHRONICLES 26:5 He sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God; and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him prosper.
- 2 CHRONICLES 31:21 And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, in the law and in the commandment, to seek his God, he did it with all his heart. So he prospered.
- 2 CHRONICLES 32:27 Hezekiah had very great riches and honour. And he made himself treasuries for silver, for gold, for precious stones, for spices, for shields, and for all kinds of desirable items;
- 2 CHRONICLES 32:29 Moreover he provided cities for himself, and possessions of flocks and herds in abundance; for God had given him very much property.
- 2 CHRONICLES 32:30 This same Hezekiah also stopped the water outlet of Upper Gihon and brought the water by tunnel to the west side of the City of David. Hezekiah prospered in all his works.
-
- NEHEMIAH 2:20 So I answered them, and said to them, "The God of heaven Himself will prosper us; therefore we His servants will arise and build..."
- NEHEMIAH 9:21 Forty years You sustained them in the wilderness so that they lacked nothing; their clothes did not wear out and their feet did not swell.
- NEHEMIAH 9:25 And they took strong cities and rich land, and possessed houses full of all goods, cisterns already dug, vineyards, olive groves, and fruit trees in abundance. So they ate and were filled and grew fat, and delighted themselves in Your great goodness.
- JOB 1:3 Also, his possessions were seven thousand sheep, three thousand camels, five hundred yokes of oxen, five hundred female donkeys, and a very large household, so that this man was the greatest of all the people of the East.



- JOB 1:8 Then the Lord said to Satan, "Have you considered My servant Job, that there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, one who fears God and shuns evil?"
- JOB 1:10 "Have You not made a hedge around him, around his household, and around all that he has on every side? You have blessed the work of his hands, and his possessions have increased in the land.
- JOB 36:11 If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.
- JOB 42:10 And the Lord restored Job's losses when he prayed for his friends. Indeed the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before.
- JOB 42:12 Now the Lord blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning; for he had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, one thousand yokes of oxen, and one thousand female donkeys.
- PSALM 1:3 He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.
- PSALM 5:12 For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; With favour You will surround him as with a shield.
- PSALM 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- PSALM 25:13 He himself shall dwell in prosperity, And his descendants shall inherit the earth.
- PSALM 29:11 The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace.



- PSALM 34:9 Oh, fear the Lord, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him.
- PSALM 34:10 The young lions lack and suffer hunger, But those who seek the Lord shall not lack any good thing.
- PSALM 35:27 Let them shout for joy and be glad, Who favour my righteous cause; And let them say continually, "Let the Lord be magnified, Who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant."
- PSALM 36:8 They are abundantly satisfied with the fullness of Your house, And You give them drink from the river of Your pleasures.
- PSALM 37:3 Trust in the Lord, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.
- PSALM 37:4 Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart.
- PSALM 37:11 But the meek shall inherit the earth, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.
- PSALM 37:25 I have been young, and now am old, Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, Nor his descendants begging bread.
- PSALM 50:10 For every beast of the forest is Mine And the cattle on a thousand hills.
- PSALM 65:9 You visit the earth and water it, You greatly enrich it; The river of God is full of water; You provide their grain, For so You have prepared it.



- PSALM 65:10 You water its ridges abundantly, You settle its furrows; You make it soft with showers, You bless its growth.
- PSALM 65:11 You crown the year with Your goodness, And Your paths drip with abundance.
- PSALM 66:12 You have caused men to ride over our heads; We went through fire and through water, But You brought us out to rich fulfilment.
- PSALM 67:7 God shall bless us, And all the ends of the earth shall fear Him.
- PSALM 68:6 God sets the solitary in families; He brings out those who are bound into prosperity, But the rebellious dwell in a dry land.
- PSALM 68:19 Blessed be the Lord, Who daily loads us with benefits, The God of our salvation! Selah
- PSALM 84:11 For the Lord God is a sun and shield; The Lord will give grace and glory; No good thing will He withhold From those who walk uprightly.
- PSALM 103:13 As a father pities his children, So the Lord pities those who fear Him.
- PSALM 107:38 He also blesses them, and they multiply greatly, And He does not let their cattle decrease.
- PSALM 112:3 Wealth and riches will be in his house, And his righteousness endures forever.



- PSALM 118:25 Save now, I pray, O Lord; O Lord, I pray, send now prosperity.
- PSALM 132:15 I will abundantly bless her provision; I will satisfy her poor with bread.
- PROVERBS 3:10 so your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine.
- PROVERBS 3:16 Length of days is in her right hand, in her left hand riches and honour.
- PROVERBS 8:18 Riches and honour are with me, enduring riches and righteousness.
- PROVERBS 8:21 that I may cause those who love me to inherit wealth, that I may fill their treasuries.
- PROVERBS 10:22 The blessing of the Lord makes one rich, and He adds no sorrow with it.
- PROVERBS 11:25 The generous soul will be made rich, and he who waters will also be watered himself.
- PROVERBS 13:22 A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, but the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.
- PROVERBS 19:4 Wealth makes many friends, but the poor is separated from his friend.



- LUKE 16:9 "And I say to you, make friends for yourselves by unrighteous mammon, that when you fail, they may receive you into everlasting habitations.
- ECCLESIASTES 9:16 Then I said: "Wisdom is better than strength. Nevertheless, the poor man's wisdom is despised, and his words are not heard.
- PROVERBS 22:4 By humility and the fear of the Lord are riches and honour and life.
- PROVERBS 22:7 The rich rules over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender.
- PROVERBS 22:9 He who has a bountiful eye will be blessed, for he gives of his bread to the poor.
- PROVERBS 24:4 by knowledge the rooms are filled with all precious and pleasant riches.
- PROVERBS 28:13 He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.
- PROVERBS 28:19 He who tills his land will have plenty of bread, but he who follows frivolity will have poverty enough!
- PROVERBS 28:20 A faithful man will abound with blessings, but he who hastens to be rich will not go unpunished.
- PROVERBS 28:25 He who is of a proud heart stirs up strife, but he who trusts in the Lord will be prospered.



- PROVERBS 28:27 He who gives to the poor will not lack, but he who hides his eyes will have many curses.
- ECCLESIASTES 5:19 As for every man to whom God has given riches and wealth, and given him the power to eat of it, to receive his heritage and rejoice in his labour--this is the gift of God.
- ECCLESIASTES 10:10 If the axe is dull, and one does not sharpen the edge, then he must use more strength, but wisdom brings success.
- ISAIAH 1:19 If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land;
- ISAIAH 30:23 Then He will give the rain for your seed with which you sow the ground, and bread of the increase of the earth; it will be fat and plenteous. In that day your cattle will feed in large pastures.
- ISAIAH 44:10 Who would form a god or cast a graven image that profits him nothing?
- ISAIAH 45:3 I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret places, That you may know that I, the Lord, Who call you by your name, am the God of Israel.
- ISAIAH 48:15 I, even I, have spoken; yes, I have called him, I have brought him, and his way will prosper.
- ISAIAH 48:17 Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: "I am the Lord your God, Who teaches you to profit, Who leads you by the way you should go.
- ISAIAH 53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes, we are healed.



- ISAIAH 55:2 Why do you spend money for what is not bread, and your wages for what does not satisfy? Listen diligently to Me, and eat what is good, and let your soul delight itself in abundance.
- ISAIAH 55:11 So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.
- ISAIAH 61:1 "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;
- JEREMIAH 2:11 Has a nation changed its gods, which are not gods? But My people have changed their Glory for what does not profit.
- JEREMIAH 23:4 "I will set up shepherds over them who will feed them; and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, nor shall they be lacking," says the Lord.
- JEREMIAH 31:14 I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance, and My people shall be satisfied with My goodness, "says the Lord.
- JEREMIAH 33:9 'Then it shall be to Me a name of joy, a praise, and an honour before all nations of the earth, who shall hear all the good that I do to them; they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and all the prosperity that I provide for it.'
- DANIEL 6:28 So this Daniel prospered in the reign of Darius and in the reign of Cyrus the Persian.
- JOEL 2:26 You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, who has dealt wondrously with you; and My people shall never be put to shame.
- HAGGAI 2:8 'The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine,' says the Lord of hosts.



- ZECHARIAH 8:12 'For the seed shall be prosperous, the vine shall give its fruit, the ground shall give her increase, and the heavens shall give their dew. I will cause the remnant of this people to possess all these things.
- MALACHI 3:10 Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and prove Me now in this, "says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven And pour out for you such blessing That there will not be room enough to receive it.
- MALACHI 3:12 "And all nations will call you blessed, for you will be a delightful land," says the Lord of hosts.
- MATTHEW 6:33 "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
- MARK 10:29 So Jesus answered and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospels,
- MARK 10:30 "who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time--houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions--and in the age to come, eternal life.
- MARK 11:24 "Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.
- LUKE 4:18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed,
- LUKE 6:38 "Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."



- JOHN 8:32 "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."
- JOHN 10:10 "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life and that they may have it more abundantly."
- JOHN 16:23 "And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you."
- JOHN 16:24 "Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full."
- ACTS 24:26 Meanwhile he also hoped that money would be given him by Paul, that he might release him. Therefore he sent for him more often and conversed with him."
- ROMANS 5:17 For if by the one man's offence death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)
- ROMANS 8:17 and if children, then heirs--heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together."
- ROMANS 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?
- ROMANS 10:11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."
- ROMANS 10:12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him."
- ROMANS 11:12 Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness!



- ROMANS 15:29 But I know that when I come to you, I shall come in the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of Christ.
- 1 CORINTHIANS 1:5 that you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge,
- 1 CORINTHIANS 1:30 But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God--and righteousness and sanctification and redemption--
- 1 CORINTHIANS 10:26 for "The earth is the Lord's, and all its fullness."
- 1 CORINTHIANS 16:2 On the first day of the week let each one of you lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper, that there be no collections when I come.
- 2 CORINTHIANS 8:9 For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.
- 2 CORINTHIANS 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, have an abundance for every good work.
- 2 CORINTHIANS 9:11 while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.
- GALATIANS 3:9 So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham.
- GALATIANS 3:13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree "),
- GALATIANS 3:14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.



- ROMANS 4:13 For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law but through the righteousness of faith.
- ROMANS 4:16 Therefore it is of faith that it might be according to grace, so that the promise might be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all
- GALATIANS 3:29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.
- EPHESIANS 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,
- PHILIPPIANS 4:19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
- 1 THESSALONIANS 4:12 that you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that you may lack nothing.
- 1 TIMOTHY 4:8 For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having the promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come.
- 1 TIMOTHY 6:17 Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.
- JAMES 1:4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.
- JAMES 1:25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.



- JAMES 5:11 Indeed we count them blessed who endure. You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end intended by the Lord--that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful.
- 1 PETER 3:9 not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.
- 1 PETER 3:10 For "He who would love life and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips from speaking guile;
- 2 PETER 1:3 as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,
- 1 JOHN 4:17 Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.
- 3 JOHN 1:2 Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.
